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WESTLAKE CITY COUNCIL MEETING DECEMBER 18, 2014 PROCEEDINGS OF PUBLIC HEARINGS AND A REGULAR SESSION

Public hearing, continued from October 16, 2014, was called to order by President of Council Michael F. Killeen at 8:03 p.m. in accordance with Article III, Section 13, of the Westlake City Charter and legal notice published in the West Life on October 8, 2014, and October 15, 2014, regarding the following legislation:

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-197: AN ORDINANCE CONSIDERING A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR A NURSING HOME.

Assistant Planning Director Will Krause explained this amendment to the zoning code.

Anthony Rhea of Legacy Health Services stated they have received their certificate of need from the State of Ohio for this project.

There being no further comments from the audience, Council President Killeen declared the public hearing on Ordinance No. 2013-197 closed.

SELECTED CORRESPONDENCE:

Communications from Recreation Director Bob DeMinico dated December 11, 2014, stating that at the November 18, 2014, Recreation Commission meeting, the commission recommended that Council approve the new 2015 Recreation Center Sunday hours, Peterson Pool season and daily guest pass guidelines, and Meadowood Golf Course rates beginning January 1, 2015.

Council acknowledged the new Recreation Center hours and Peterson pool guidelines and took no action on the Meadowood Golf Course rates. Therefore, if no further objections or amendments, they will automatically go into effect 60 days from the date of passage by the Recreation Commission.

Communication from Mayor Clough dated December 18, 2014, requesting authorization to solicit proposals for professional engineering services for master detention basin investigation

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within the upper Cahoon Creek drainage area including the Rose, Kirk, Sandy Ridge, Costello (I & II), and Westwood basins for the potential benefits of lowering the flood elevations.

Councilmember O'Donnell moved, seconded by Councilmember Nunnari, to authorize the administration to solicit proposals for professional engineering services for master detention basin investigation within the upper Cahoon Creek drainage area including the Rose, Kirk, Sandy Ridge, Costello (I & II), and Westwood basins for the potential benefits of lowering the flood elevations.

Councilmember Getsay reported on the December 15, 2014, planning commission meeting advising that the commission took the following actions: Crocker Park G Block (minor revisions to approved plans), within Crocker Park G Block: The Planning Commission gave unanimous consent to postpone this item to the January 5, 2015, meeting. Ordinance 2014-168 conditional use permit for mobile food vending, 29305 Clemens Road, PP#211-22-056 to 059: The planning commission made the following findings of fact: 1. Although the two ordinances that enable this use are still before Council, the Planning Commission is able to make a recommendation regarding this CUP, provided that it be conditioned upon the approval of the ordinances. 2. The modification to reduce the number of required parking spaces by 5 is reasonable, since it meets the performance standards for modifications in section 1220.06, and the tasting room is likely to experience the most use after regular business hours. 3. The proposed use meets the standards for evaluating conditional use permits in section 1227.03. Motion: Mr. Fatzinger moved and Mr. Lamb second to recommend approval of Ordinance 2014-168 with the following conditions and modification: 1. Approval is subject to the adoption of Ordinances 2014-166 and 2014-167. 2. A modification is granted to reduce the total number of required parking spaces to 58. 3. The mobile food vending shall be located on a paved surface and shall not interfere with ingress to or egress from the building. 4. The location of the mobile food vending unit is subject to the approval of the planning department. 5. That the hours of

operation be limited to 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Meeting adjourned at 9:37 p.m. The next regular meeting is scheduled for Monday, January 5, 2015, in the Westlake City Hall Council Chambers.
