



**CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 2015-1:**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER
169 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE AS
TO PERSONNEL IN THE COMMUNITY
SERVICES DEPARTMENT, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Council desires upon the recommendation of the Mayor and the Director of the Community Services Department to repeal Section 169.02 and supplement Section 169.03 of the Administrative Code as to personnel within the Community Services Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That Section 169.02 entitled "ASSISTANT DIRECTOR" is hereby repealed.

Section 2: That Section 169.03 entitled "OTHER PERSONNEL" be and the same shall be supplemented and as supplemented shall read as follows:

"169.03 OTHER PERSONNEL.

The following additional positions are hereby established and shall be in the unclassified service of the City pursuant to Charter IV, Section 12(c):

Office Manager – Full-time
Two (2) Program/Activity Planners - Full-time
Program/Activity Planners - Part-time
Transportation Coordinators - Part-time
Office Clerks - Part-time
Maintenance Persons - Part-time
Driver - Full-time
Drivers - Part-time
Youth Coordinator - Part-time
Outreach Coordinator - Full-time

Section 3: That any Ordinance or parts of Ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the continuity of services within the Community Services Department, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approved by the Mayor.
