A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A DONATION OF POLICE EQUIPMENT FROM UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL ST. JOHN MEDICAL CENTER.

WHEREAS, University Hospital St. John Medical Center has donated a Kimtek Research Medlite Transport Deluxe Rescue Insert for use with the Police Department's Utility Terrain Vehicle; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to accept this donation on behalf of the City of Westlake for use by the Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

<u>Section 1</u>: Council hereby accepts the donation of a Kimtek Research Medlite Transport Deluxe Rescue Insert for use with the Police Department's Utility Terrain Vehicle.

Section 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
