



**CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 2015-12:**

**AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION
OF HOURLY RATE EMPLOYEES IN THE
SERVICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF
WESTLAKE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE,
COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:**

Section 1: That the compensation of salaried personnel and hourly rate personnel in the Service Department of the City of Westlake, shall be payable bi-weekly as of March 1, 2015 as follows:

<u>POSITION</u>	<u>PAY RANGE</u>
Operator	22.60 to 24.60 per hour
Mechanic I	22.60 to 26.10 per hour
Mechanic II	20.94 to 22.59 per hour
Service Worker I	22.60 to 24.60 per hour
Service Worker II	20.39 to 22.59 per hour
Service Worker III	16.00 to 20.38 per hour
Dispatcher	16.52 to 17.20 per hour
Temporary Replacement Worker	8.10 to 16.00 per hour

Section 2: That the Director of the Service Department of the City, where there is indicated a minimum and maximum salary or hourly rate to be paid shall have the discretion to recommend an increase in an employee's salary or hourly rate, and each employee will receive such increase provided that the increase in the salary or hourly rate shall be approved by the Mayor, and subject further to the condition that the Council has appropriated sufficient monies in the various payroll accounts to provide for such increases.

Section 3: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

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Section 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to maintain the continuity of services in the service department in the City, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
