



CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2015-122:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2012-62 AS TO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH HATCH MOTT MacDONALD, LLC, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by and through Ordinance No. 2012-62, Council authorized a Contract with Hatch Mott MacDonald, LLC for the performance of professional services related to the Columbia Road Interchange Project (PID 88665); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Director of Engineering have recommended that Section 2 of said Ordinance be amended to provide for additional funds necessary to cover the cost of contract modifications which will allow the City to take advantage of available safety funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2012-62 be and the same is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

"Section 2: That the Director of Finance be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue warrants of the City of Westlake to Hatch Mott MacDonald, LLC in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Five and Seventy-One Cents (\$495,325.71) upon the approval of the Mayor and the Director Engineering."

Section 2: That any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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<u>Section 4:</u> That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide necessary contract modifications for access to available safety funding for the Columbia Road Interchange Project (PID 88665), and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
