



CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2015-123:

> AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2014-176 AS TO A PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH SIGNAL SERVICE COMPANY, INC., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by and through Ordinance No. 2014-176, Council authorized the Mayor to contract with Signal Service Company, Inc. for the maintenance and repair of the City's traffic signals in 2015; and

WHEREAS, it is vital that the City retain their services for repairs needed by the Departments of Engineering, Service and Police as they have a complete understanding of our existing traffic signal network; and

WHEREAS, this Personal Services Contract is exempt from public bidding pursuant to Westlake Charter Article V, Section 5(b).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2014-176 be and the same is hereby amended which as amended shall read as follows:

"<u>Section 2</u>: That the Director of Finance be and he hereby is authorized and directed to issue warrants of The City of Westlake to Signal Service Company, Inc. in an amount not to exceed Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00) for calendar year 2015."

Section 3: That any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 5</u>: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the maintenance of all traffic signals, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be enforce immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
