



CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2015-138:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PURCHASE A TRUCK UTILITY BODY WITH SELECTED OPTIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Westlake received six competitive quotes for one (1) Truck Utility Body with selected options needed in the Department of Public Service; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Purchasing has advised this Council that the City of Westlake can purchase the Truck Utility Body with selected options needed in the Department of Public Service from Fallsway Equipment Co., Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to accept said quote and reject all others.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized to purchase one (1) Truck Utility Body with selected options needed in the Department of Public Service as follows:

SUPPLIER:

Fallsway Equipment Co., Inc.

Akron, Ohio 44310

EQUIPMENT:

One (1) Truck Utility Body with selected options

PRICE:

Not to exceed \$26,000.00

Section 2: That the Director of Finance be and he hereby is authorized and directed to issue warrants of the City of Westlake for said equipment to the supplier listed in Section 1 above in an amount not to exceed the sum of Twenty-Six Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$26,000.00).

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action

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were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4</u>: That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to continue the efficiency of the Department of Public Service, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
