



CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2015-18:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2014-60 AS TO THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) FORD VANS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by and through Ordinance No. 2014-60, amended by Ordinance No. 2014-119, Council authorized and directed the Mayor to enter into a Contract for the purchase of two (2) Ford Transit Connect Vans with selected options; and

WHEREAS, the 2015 model year of these vehicles is available through the City of Columbus, Ohio Bid for Automobiles, Solicitation No. SA004729, from Byers Ford; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Director of Purchasing have recommended that the cost of the vehicles authorized in Ordinance No. 2014-60 be amended to correct an error in the price quoted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 2014-60 be and the same is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

"Section 1:

SUPPLIER:

Byers Ford

1101 Columbus Pike Delaware, Ohio 43015

EQUIPMENT:

Two (2) Ford Transit Connect Vans

with selected options

PRICE:

Not to exceed \$43,230.00

Section 2: That the Director of Finance be and he hereby is authorized and directed to issue warrants of the City of Westlake for said equipment to the supplier listed in Section 1 above in an amount not to exceed the sum of Forty-Three Thousand Two Hundred Thirty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$43,230.00)."

Section 2: That any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to continue the efficiency of the various departments, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
