



CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2015-19:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2012-102 AS TO A PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, by and through Ordinance No. 2012-102, Council authorized and directed the Mayor to enter into a personal services contract with Bialosky + Partners as to architectural and engineering services for the Westlake civic space; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Director of Engineering have recommended that the cost of the services authorized in Ordinance No. 2012-102, as amended by Ordinance No. 2013-25, be again amended to provide for additional funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

**Section 1:** That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2012-102 be and the same is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

"Section 2: That the Director of Finance be and he is hereby authorized to issue warrants of the City of Westlake to Bialosky + Partners in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$322,650.00) when approved by the Mayor."

<u>Section 2</u>: That any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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<u>Section 4</u>: That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for additional architectural and engineering services for the City civic space, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
