## CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2015-33:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS WITH BAILEYS COMMUNICATIONS FOR MAINTENANCE, TECHNICAL AND INSTALLATION SERVICES FOR THE CITY'S NETWORK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Director of Purchasing recommend that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into a 2015 Maintenance Agreement with Baileys Communications for the City network maintenance for the Information Technology and Police Departments; and

WHEREAS, the Information Technology and Police Departments also use Baileys Communication as network service provider as well as support on technical items not covered under the Maintenance Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Director of Purchasing do also hereby recommend that Council authorize additional expenditures outside the Maintenance Agreement with Baileys Communications as necessary to maintain the City's network and support services throughout the 2015 year.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a 2015 Maintenance Agreement with Baileys Communications, which agreement shall be kept on file in the Departments of Purchasing and Finance in a form approved by the Director of Law. Further, he is hereby authorized to expend funds for technical support, repairs, and installations outside of the Maintenance Agreement all in an amount not to exceed Thirty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars and Zero Cents (\$33,425.00).

Section 2: That the Director of Finance be and he hereby is authorized and directed to issue warrants of The City of Westlake to Baileys Communications, the total amount of which shall not to exceed Thirty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars and Zero Cents (\$33,425.00), upon the approval of the Mayor.

<u>Section 3</u>: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4</u>: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for continuity of services within the Information Technology and Police Departments, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be enforce immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
