



CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2015-36:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZE PURCHASE ORDER REQUESTS WITH B&C COMMUNICATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Director of Purchasing recommend that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into Maintenance Agreements with B&C Communications for the 2-Way Radio and Alerting Systems for the Westshore Central Dispatch Center and Police Radio Room; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Director of Purchasing have further recommended that Council authorize the Mayor to purchase an upgrade of the WESTCOM Dispatch Radio Control System; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Director of Purchasing do also hereby recommend that Council authorize the Mayor to approve Super Blanket Purchase Order Requests for WESTCOM, Police and Fire Departments as necessary for repairs of 2-way radio equipment and other miscellaneous minor repairs for the City departments throughout the 2015 year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter into Maintenance Agreements with B&C Communications as to the maintenance of the Westshore Central Dispatch Center's 2-Way Radio and Alerting Systems and the Police Radio Room, which agreements shall be kept on file in the Department of Purchasing in a form as approved by the Director of Law. The Mayor is further authorized to expend funds for the necessary repairs of the Police and Fire 2-Way Radio equipment, upgrade of the Dispatch Radio Control System and other miscellaneous expenses for the City departments throughout the 2015 year.

Section 2: That the Director of Finance be and he hereby is authorized and directed to issue warrants of The City of Westlake to B&C Communications for calendar year 2015 in a

total amount not to exceed Forty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$44,500.00), upon the approval of the Mayor.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for continuity of emergency communications at the Westshore Central Dispatch Center, Police and Fire Departments, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be enforce immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
