



**CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 2015-37:**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A BID AND
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO
A CONTRACT WITH MILLER BUILDERS FOR
CONSTRUCTION OF A SALT STORAGE
BUILDING FOR THE CITY OF WESTLAKE,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to an advertisement, the City received three (3) bid proposals for construction of a salt storage building; and

WHEREAS, after careful analysis of the bids received, the Mayor and the Director of Engineering have recommended that Council accept the bid proposal of Miller Builders for said improvements; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that the bid proposal of Miller Builders is the lowest and best bid proposal; and

WHEREAS, this Council hereby accepts the bid of Miller Builders and rejects all other bid proposals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Contract with Miller Builders for construction of a salt storage building, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Director of Engineering, which Contract shall be kept on file in the Department of Engineering and be in a form as approved by the Director of Law.

Section 2: That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to issue warrants of the City of Westlake to Miller Builders in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Forty-Seven Thousand One Hundred Eighty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$347,180.00), when approved by the Mayor and the Director of Engineering.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to protect and store salt in an economical and environmentally safe manner, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
