



CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2015-44:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PURCHASE TWO LATERAL CAMERAS AND AUTHORIZE PURCHASE ORDER REQUESTS WITH MTECH COMPANY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council, by Ordinance No. 1987-50, authorized the Mayor, under the Ohio Cooperative Purchase Act, to purchase supplies, service equipment and materials, through participation in State Contracts with the Ohio Department of Administrative Services; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Purchasing has advised this Council that the City can purchase two (2) Lateral Cameras, Contract No. 800001, Index No. STS670, needed for the Engineering and Public Service Departments through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program from MTech Company; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Director of Purchasing do also hereby recommend that Council authorize the Mayor to approve Super Blanket Purchase Order Requests for the Engineering and Public Service Departments as necessary for Johnston Street Sweeper and Cues Camera Truck parts and equipment from MTech Company throughout the 2015 year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized to purchase two (2) Lateral Cameras, Contract No. 800001, Index No. STS670, needed for the Engineering and Public Service Departments through the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Service – Office of Purchasing under the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Act as provided through Ordinance 1987-50 at the prices provided in accordance with the State of Ohio contracts from MTech Company. The Mayor is further authorized to expend funds for the Johnston Street Sweeper and Cues Camera Truck parts and equipment from MTech Company.

- Section 2: That the Director of Finance be and he hereby is authorized and directed to issue warrants of The City of Westlake to MTech Company in a total amount not to exceed Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$35,000.00) for the calendar year 2015, upon the approval of the Mayor.
- Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- <u>Section 4</u>: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to continue the efficiency of the Engineering and Public Service Departments, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be enforce immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
