



CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2015-45:

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A QUOTE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PURCHASE ONE (1) UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE AND NECESSARY SAFETY EQUIPMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Westlake received three competitive quotes for one (1) New Current Model Year Polaris Ranger 900-6 XP Utility-Terrain Vehicle (UTV) and necessary safety equipment needed in the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, this vehicle and necessary safety equipment are not currently available through any Cooperative Purchasing Programs; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Director of Purchasing hereby recommend that Council authorize the purchase of one (1) New Current Model Year Polaris Ranger 900-6 XP UTV from All Ohio Motorsports and other necessary safety equipment from various vendors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized to purchase necessary UTV safety equipment from various vendors and one (1) New Current Model Year Polaris Ranger 900-6 XP Utility-Terrain Vehicle (UTV) for use in the Police Department from the suppliers listed as follows:

Section 2: That the Director of Finance be and he hereby is authorized and directed to issue warrants of the City of Westlake for said vehicle and necessary safety equipment to the suppliers listed in Section 1 above in an amount not to exceed the sum of Nineteen Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$19,000.00).

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4</u>: That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for the Police Department to have a capable vehicle for special events, crowd control, off-road searches and other unique situations in addition to continuing the efficiency of the Police Department, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
