CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2015-54:

> AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A QUOTE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PURCHASE ONE (1) ROLAND VERSAL EXPRESS PLOTTER WITH SELECTED OPTIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Westlake received five competitive quotes for one (1) Large Format Printer and Plotter with selected options needed in the Service Department; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Purchasing has advised this Council that the City can purchase one (1) Roland Versal Express Plotter with selected options from Hasco Graphics, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized to purchase one (1) Roland Versal Express Plotter with selected options, less trade-in allowance by seller, for use in the Service Department from the supplier listed as follows:

SUPPLIER:	Hasco Graphics, Inc. 23070 Miles Road
	Cleveland, Ohio 44128
EQUIPMENT:	One (1) Roland Versal Express Plotter with selected options
TRADE-IN:	Trade-in allowance by seller of existing Roland SC540EX Plotter (-\$250.00)
PRICE:	Not to exceed \$29,000.00

Section 2: That the Director of Finance be and he is hereby authorized to issue warrants of the City of Westlake in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Nine Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$29,000.00) to Hasco Graphics, Inc. upon the approval of the Mayor.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and

that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4</u>: That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the continuation of highly visible and cost effective sign production to enhance communication, safety, and visual impact on public displays, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
