



**CITY OF WESTLAKE, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 2015-68:**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF
ORDINANCE NO. 2014-105 AS TO THE
PAVEMENT MARKINGS WITHIN THE CITY
OF WESTLAKE, AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, by and through Ordinance No. 2014-105, Council authorized and directed the Mayor to enter into a contract with Dura Mark, Inc. for the Pavement Markings of Certain Streets and Highways within the City of Westlake; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Director of Purchasing have recommended the City exercise the second application clause, per section 2.4.2 of the 2014 bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 2014-105 be and the same is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

Section 3: That the Director of Finance be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue warrants of the City of Westlake to Dura Mark, Inc. in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Thirty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$438,500.00) upon the approval of the Mayor and the Director of Purchasing.

Section 2: That any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary continue the pavement and markings of certain

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streets and highways within the City of Westlake, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be enforce immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
