

EQUIPMENT: One (1) Backhus A55 Model self-propelled straddle type windrow turner less trade-in allowance of existing 1989 Scarab Model 18 windrow turner by seller (-\$15,000.00)

PRICE: Not to exceed \$356,650.00, of which fifty percent (50%) shall be paid by the City of Westlake and fifty percent (50%) shall be paid by the City of Bay Village.

Section 2: That the Director of Finance be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue warrants of the City of Westlake for said equipment to the supplier listed in Section 1 above in an amount not to exceed the sum One Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars and Zero Cents (\$178,325.00).

Section 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 10, Article XI of the Charter of the City of Westlake and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary to continue the efficiency of the Westlake-Bay Village Compost Facility, and further provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
